
STAGE 1

STAGE 3

For mildly tuned machines using individual filters or velocity stacks. K&N filters #RC-1824

Both stages may be used with a good aftermarket exhaust





STAGE ONE INSTRUCTIONS

1. Remove the vacuum slide from the carbs. Remove the stock needles & spacers, noting the order of assembly.
2. Use the slide drill (DD #7/64) provided to enlarge the slide lift hole (Fig. A).
3. Install the Dynojet needles on groove #3, using all stock spacers (Fig. A). There are no adjusting washers for this kit.
4. Remove the main jet and replace with the Dynojet main jets provided. Use the DJ076 main jets with stock exhaust, or use the DJ080 main jets with aftermarket headers or slip-ons with free flowing baffles. Be sure that the jets you are changing are the main jets.
5. Locate the fuel mixture plug (Fig. B), if you see a screw head, proceed to adjusting procedure. With the plug drill (DD #5/32) provided, carefully drill thru the plugs. *NOTE: the mixture screw is directly underneath this plug, be ready to pull back on the drill the instant you break through.* Use screw provided to secure and remove the plug. Carefully turn mixture screw clockwise until seated, then back out 2-1/2 turns.



STAGE THREE INSTRUCTIONS

1. Remove the vacuum slide from the carbs. Remove the stock needles & spacers, noting the order of assembly.
2. Use the slide drill (DD #7/64) provided to enlarge the slide lift hole (Fig. A).
3. Install the Dynojet needles on groove #2, using all stock spacers (Fig. A). There are no adjusting washers for this kit.
4. Remove the main jet and replace with the Dynojet main jets provided. Use the DJ106 main jets with stock exhaust, or use the DJ110 main jets with aftermarket headers or slip-ons with free flowing baffles. Be sure that the jets you are changing are the main jets.
5. Locate the fuel mixture plug (Fig. B), if you see a screw head, proceed to adjusting procedure. With the plug drill (DD #5/32) provided, carefully drill thru the plugs. *NOTE: the mixture screw is directly underneath this plug, be ready to pull back on the drill the instant you break through.* Use screw provided to secure and remove the plug. Carefully turn mixture screw clockwise until seated, then back out 2-1/2 turns.
